counsel appearing on behalf of the State Food Corporation as well

as learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks extension of time for depositing
the amount fixed in the order dated 21.08.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though
he had taken his bail after surrendering in the court below, the time
fixed for depositing of the money could not be adhered to and he
thus seeks the extension of the time. He further submits that the
entire amount has now been paid. He now prays for extension of time
till the date he deposited the money i.e till 01.07.2016. Accordingly,
the time fixed in the order for depositing of the amount stands

extended till the said date.
