Heard learned counsels for the petitioner

and the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in  
a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections  
366A and 379 of the Indian Penal Code.

The prosecution case is of abducting the  
minor daughter of the informant.

In 164 Cr.P.C. statement the victim has got  
her age recorded as 18 years when the court has assessed as 16  
years where she has stated that she was in love with Amit hence  
performed marriage and she wants to reside with him.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the  
petitioner that the victim has not named the petitioner and a

statement has been made in paragraph 3 of the petition that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Considering the 164 Cr.P.C. statement of the victim, let the above named petitioner be released on anticipatory bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of twelve weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gaya in connection with Gaya Muffasil P.S. Case No. 141 of 2015, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
