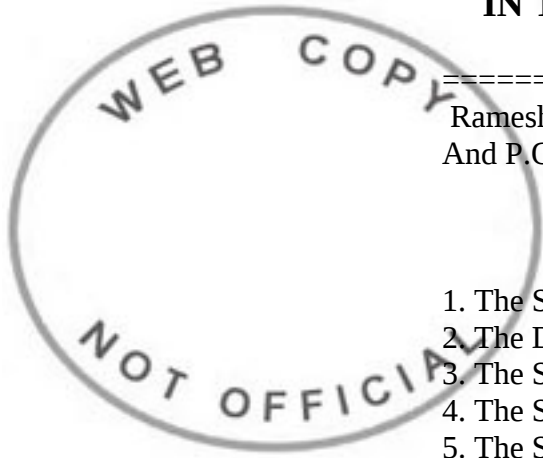

The writ application seeks a direction to provide the protection of life and property to him by the respondents-State.

In my view, the application deserves to be disposed of permitting the petitioner to represent his grievance before the respondent-District Magistrate as well as the Superintendent of Police, who shall consider/examine the necessity, if any, of providing such protection to the petitioner on payment of cash or even otherwise.
