3 26-07-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in a case instituted
for the offences under Section 28 of the Pre Natal Diagnostic
Techniques Act, 1994 read with the Rules 1996 and Section
200 of the Code of Criminal Procedure..

Allegation has been made that petitioner is running a
Ultra Sound Clinic in the name and style of Gupta Ultra Sound
Clinic. Allegation has been made about violation of statutory
provision not with respect to particular person but general and
vague allegation has been made against large number of persons.

Looking to the facts and circumstances of the case, in

the event of arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, let petitioner, Radhe Shyam Gupta, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Aurangabad in connection with G.O. Case No.32 of 2015, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
