None appears on behalf of the petitioner to press the writ

Mr. Kameshwar Kumar, learned G.P.-17 for the State is
present and submits that the petitioner was found absent from duty
during the course of inspection and which resulted in imposition of
penalty of withholding a one annual increment with cumulative effect
as well as censure. He submits that there is no dispute on the absence
of the petitioner and there was no leave application as well on record
so there is nothing to contest the position and in the circumstances the

petitioner has been visited with the appropriate punishment.

Since there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner, this Court on perusal of the records and in consideration of the arguments advanced by Mr. Kumar, learned G.P.-17, does not find reasons to interfere with the punishment order.

The writ petition is dismissed.
