2 17-08-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

This Court has passed the final order on 17th September 2014 in C.W.J.C. No. 25291 of 2013 whereby the order passed by the Circle Officer in Miscellaneous Case No. 3/2013-14 has been quashed, subject to result of Title Appeal No. 35 of 2009, which was pending before the Adhoc Additional Sessions Judge-II, Barh, Patna. It has been informed by the counsel for the State that the appeal was decided against the petitioner which was

challenged before the second Appellate Authority i.e. this Court unsuccessfully. The matter is pending before the Hon’ble Supreme Court.
