2. The present Letters Patent Appeal is directed against the order of the learned Single Bench passed on 26th of November, 2015 in CWJC No. 14660 of 2015 whereby an order dated 2nd of

September, 2015 posting the respondent no. 7 against the post of the writ applicant was set aside.
