2 22-04-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with
Amnour P.S. Case No. 97 of 2015 registered for the offences
punishable under Sections 341, 324, 307 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though
there is allegation against the petitioner under Section 307 of the
Indian Penal Code, but no case is made out against the petitioner
under the aforementioned section, as there has been no repetition
of blow and there is no clear intention to kill.

Considering the nature of injury and also the fact that
the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent, let the petitioner
above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the
court below within a period of four weeks from the date of

receipt/production of a copy of this order, is/are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Saran at Chapra in connection with Amnour P.S. Case No. 97 of 2015, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
