2 09-02-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as
learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner is named in the first information report on
the accusation that he along with others kidnapped the informant's
daughter but submission on behalf of the petitioner is that the
statement of victim has been recorded under Section 164 of the
Cr.P.C. in which she specifically stated that she solemnized her
marriage with petitioner by her own sweet will and she was never
kidnapped by the petitioner. It is further submitted by him that
victim was major at the time of alleged occurrence.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as
well as submissions of the parties, let the petitioner be released on

bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Special Judge(POCSO), Bhagalpur in connection with Sanhaua P.S. Case No. 111 of 2015.
