2 08-02-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner is in custody since 28.08.2015 in connection with Mansoor Chak P.S. Case No.53/2015 for the offences punishable under Sections 25(1-b) a, 26, 35 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though there was recovery of one country made pistol from the possession of the petitioner but there is no independent witness to support the alleged recovery. He further submits that the petitioner is in custody since 28.08.2015 i.e. for more than five months.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances of the case and also that the petitioner has been in jail for more

than five months, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10, 000/- (Rs. Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub-Judge-IV-cum-Assistant Chief Judicial Magistrate 2nd Class, Besusarai, in connection with Mansoor Chak P.S. Case No.53/2015.
