2 02-03-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. representing the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Alamnagar (Ratwara O.P.) P.S. Case No. 73 of 2015 (G.R. No.388
of 2015) registered for the offences punishable under Sections
25(1-B)a, 26 of the Arms Act.

Allegedly the petitioner was caught after chase and
from his possession one country made loaded pistol was
recovered.

Submission is of false implication and that the
petitioner is suffering in custody since 27.05.2015, nothing was
recovered from conscious possession of the petitioner and he has
been made victim of the circumstances, the wife of the petitioner
after getting the police officer in collusion, got implicated the

petitioner.

The learned A.P.P. submits that the petitioner has got criminal antecedent.

In the facts and circumstances stated above, the petitioner above named is directed to be released on bail on execution of bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Uda-Kishunganj, in connection with Alamnagar (Ratwara O.P.) P.S. Case No.73 of 2015, subject to conditions that one of the bailors must be near relative and another having sufficient immovable property within the territorial jurisdiction of the court concerned and the petitioner shall remain present on each and every date during trial and the default on two consecutive dates on his part without any reason shall disentitle the petitioner from privilege of bail.
