ORAL JUDGMENT

Date: 30-01-2016

Since the petitioner alleges certain mala fide against the erstwhile Headmaster of the School, who was bent upon creating one impediment or the other and preventing the petitioner from deriving benefit of retiral dues etc., the Court directs the District Education Officer, Munger to give an opportunity to the petitioner to explain all the details of the so-called dues and the reconciliation which has already been done by the petitioner. On an opportunity so given and on hearing the petitioner, satisfying himself on the issue, he will authorize payment of pension etc. in favour of the petitioner, preferably, within a period of three months from the date of production of a copy of this order.

It is made clear that if there is any outstanding dues, worked out on the basis of record and if the petitioner has already deposited that amount, it will

be taken into consideration. If there is any discrepancy, petitioner should do the needful.

Writ application is disposed of in terms of the above.
