Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner is not named but submission on behalf
of the petitioner is that except confessional statement of co-
accused persons as well as some criminal antecedents of the
petitioner, there appears to be nothing against him.

From perusal of the impugned order it would appear
that the learned Additional Sessions Judge has written a very long
and detailed order but he failed to mention as to how the name of
the petitioner came in this case.

Moreover, considering the aforesaid submissions as
well as facts and circumstances, particularly keeping in mind that
the petitioner is in jail custody since 17.09.2014, but up till now he
has not been put on Test Identification Parade in the present case,

let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sitamarhi in Nanpur P.S. Case No. 161 of 2014.
