2 11-04-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State and learned counsel, appearing for the informant.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under Sections-302, 307 & other minor sections of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner is named in the first information report with accusation that he opened fire but the informant admitted in his written report that the firing of the petitioner did not hit the deceased. Furthermore, the allegation of assault by different weapons is against other accused. The postmortem report of the deceased also corroborates this fact that the deceased sustained injury, said to be caused by hard and blunt substances.

Considering the above-said facts and circumstances of

the case as well as submission of the parties, let the petitioner named above, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each in connection with Andar (M.H. Nagar) P.S. Case No. 03 of 2016 to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Siwan.
