4 02-03-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

State.

Petitioner has renewed his prayer for bail is languishing in custody since 07.02.2013 in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 302, 120B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The prosecution case is that the petitioner crushed the son of the informant Brij Mohan Giri for protesting against the rash and negligent driving.

The earlier report of the learned trial court dated 12.09.2014 suggested that the trial will be concluded within a period of six months. The last report of the learned Additional District & Sessions Judge-II, Saran, Chapra dated 20.02.2016 suggest that out of 16 charge-sheeted witnesses five have been examined and rest 11 are left to be

examined. Hence, the trial is likely to be concluded within a period of six months.

Considering the stage of trial, this Court is not inclined to interfere.

It is expected from the Superintendent of Police, Saran, Chapra to produce the rest of the witnesses at the earliest.

It is expected from the learned court below to conclude the trial within the time framed for transmit to this Court.

Accordingly, the application is disposed of.

If the trial is not concluded within a period of six months, the petitioner will pray for regular bail before the learned court below.
