2 05-05-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Vishanupad
P.S. Case No.05 of 2016/G.R. No.139 of 2016 registered under
Section 364 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. The name of
the petitioner surfaced in this case during the course of
investigation in the confessional statement of the co-accused
Ranjeet Paswan, who is said to be the driver of the vehicle in
question. Except that, there is no material to show the
involvement of the petitioner in this case. While the informant has

detailed the physique of the culprits in the F.I.R. but the petitioner has not been put on T.I. Parade while he is in custody since 15.01.2016.

Having regard to the facts and the circumstances of the case, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gaya, in connection with Vishanupad P.S. Case No.05 of 2016/G.R. No.139 of 2016. Out of the two sureties, one must be close relative of the petitioner, who will file an affidavit giving genealogy as to how he/she is related with the petitioner. The bailors will undertake to furnish information to the court about any change in the address of the petitioner.
