Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Kankarbagh P.S. Case No. 197 of 2016 registered under
Sections 4, 5 and 7 of the Immoral Traffic Act, 1956.

It is submitted that there is no material to support
the allegation that the petitioner was living on the earning of
prostitution or inducing or taking any person for the sake of
prostitution or was carrying on prostitution in the vicinity of
public places. It is further submitted that the entire FIR has been
instituted on the basis of wild suspicion and hypothetical

presumption.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor of the State has opposed the application for bail.

Regard being had to the nature of allegation, the petitioner, who is in custody since 22nd March, 2016, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate-1st Class, Patna in connection with Kankarbagh P.S. Case No. 197 of 2016.
