Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned

counsel representing the State.

As prayed for, learned counsel for the petitioner is
permitted to make necessary correction in the prayer portion.

The petitioner wants to renew his prayer of bail, which
was earlier rejected vide order dated 22.01.2016 passed in Cr.
Misc. No. 55054 of 2015, on the ground that the petitioner is in
custody since 07.08.2015 and now he has sufficiently been
penalized, due to inadvertence earlier it was not stated that charge
has already been framed on 06.10.2015 and as such the petitioner
deserves sympathetic consideration and in near future the trial is
not likely to be concluded.

Learned APP fairly submits that now the petitioner by
remaining in custody has been sufficiently penalized.

In the facts and circumstances stated above, the petitioner

above named is directed to be released on bail on execution of bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge VII, Gopalganj in Sessions Trial No. 444 of 2015 arising out of Mirganj P.S. Case No. 175 of 2003, subject to the conditions that one of the bailors must be a near relative and another having sufficient immovable property within the territorial jurisdiction of the court concerned and the petitioner shall remain present on each and every date during trial and the default on two consecutive dates on his part without any reason shall disentitle the petitioner from privilege of bail.
