The Petitioner seeks quashing of the order dated 10.12.2013 passed by the Principal Judge, Family Court, Kaimur at Bhabhua by which it has directed the Petitioner to pay ad-interim maintenance of Rs. 2,000/- per month to the Opposite Party No. 2 and Rs. 1,000/- per month to the Opposite Party No. 3 in Maintenance Case No. 52 of 2010.

Considering that the impugned order is merely one of ad-interim maintenance, I see no reason for interference and, hence, the application stands dismissed.

The Court below is directed to conclude the proceeding positively within a period of four months from the date of receipt of this order without granting unnecessary adjournment to any party if he has not done so already.
