2 30-08-2016 Heard Mr. Abdul Mannan Khan, learned Counsel,

appearing on behalf of the petitioner, and Mr. Iqbal Asif Niyazi,

learned Counsel for the State-respondents.

The grievance of the petitioner is that he is an
accused in Samastipur Mahila Police Station Case No.42 of 2014.
Despite the fact that no evidence has been collected so far, the
investigation is still kept pending.

Having considered the averments made in the writ
petition and materials on record and upon hearing the parties, it is
hereby directed that respondent No.2, namely, Superintendent of
Police, Samastipur, shall enquire into the grievances raised in the
writ petition, do the needful in accordance with law and get the

investigation of Samastipur Mahila P.S. Case No.42 of 2014 completed expeditiously, preferably, within a period of six months, ensuring proper, fair and effective investigation in such a way that no innocent person is harassed.

Let a copy of this order be sent forthwith to the Superintendent of Police, Samastipur, and Officer-in-Charge, Samastipur Mahila Police Station.

With the aforesaid observations and directions, this writ petition stands disposed of.
