Heard learned counsel for the parties.

2. The petitioner is the informant on whose statement Vidyapati Nagar P.S. Case No. 36/2014 for the offences under Sections 323, 341, 325, 448 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code was registered on 6th of February, 2014.

3. A perusal of the petition shows that after completion of the investigation, charge-sheet has been submitted on 31st of October, 2014 and the matter is pending before the Court.

4. Since the matter is pending before the Court, it

shall be open to the petitioner to raise all such pleas as are raised in the present petition before the Trial Court for redressal of the grievances. No further orders are called for in the present petition.
