Since the petitioner was appointed on contract and is not a permanent appointee under the State, by giving an opportunity to the petitioner to agitate the issue before the concerned authorities enough leeway has been shown to him. In the opinion of the Court, such matters are not required to be entertained under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

If the petitioner is not satisfied with the decision, contained in Annexure-I dated 10/07/2013, he may invoke the powers of a civil

court of competent jurisdiction.

The issue must rest at that.

Writ application is dismissed with above liberty.
