Petitioner has renewed his prayer for bail is languishing in custody since 08.04.2014 in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 302, 307, 323, 324, 341, 354, 379, 436, 120B of the Indian Penal Code and 3(1) (iv) (v) (x) (xi)/ 3 (2) (iii) (iv) (v) (vi) of the S.C./S.T.(Prevention of Atrocities) Act in connection with Fulkaha P.S.
