The petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in connection
with Chanpatia P.S. Case No. 240 of 2015 registered under
Sections 143, 341, 323, 324, 452, 380, 307, 149 of the Indian
Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Regard being had to the serious nature of allegation
made in the FIR which finds duly corroborated by the injury as
