This is the 3rd round the petitioner has renewed his prayer for bail in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 20, 22, 23, 24, 27(A) and 29 of the NDPS Act.

830 kgs. of Ganja were recovered from a truck being driven by this petitioner.

The order dated 29.04.2015 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 4227 of 2015 whereby the prayer for bail of the petitioner was earlier rejected suggests that the FSL report was awaited till close of evidence when the order was directed to be transmitted to the Director, FSL, Patna, Bihar. The report has not

been transmitted till day.

It is expected from the Director, FSL, Patna, Bihar to transmit the report forthwith in connection with Bhangaha P.S. Case No. 03 of 2013, Trial No. 46 of 2013, pending in the court of learned Additional Sessions Judge-III, West Champaran, Bettiah.

It is expected from the learned trial court to conclude the trial within a period of three months.

Considering the commercial quantity of recovery, this Court is not inclined to interfere. Accordingly, this application is disposed of.

Let the order be transmitted to Director, FSL, Patna and learned Additional Sessions Judge III, West Champaran at Bettiah.
