The petitioner prays for reconstitution of the Gram
Panchayat Mahammadpur Mubarak as per the provisions of the
Bihar Panchayat Raj Act, 2006.

Issue of delimitation or re-constitution of a Panchayat
lies entirely within the domain of the statutory authority under the
Bihar Panchayat Raj Act, 2006 and the Election Rules framed

thereunder.

This Court sitting in writ jurisdiction in such circumstances would refrain from entering into such domain. The writ petition is disposed of accordingly.

The petitioner, if so advised, may pursue the remedy as available to him under Section 11 of the Act, departmentally.
