ORAL ORDER

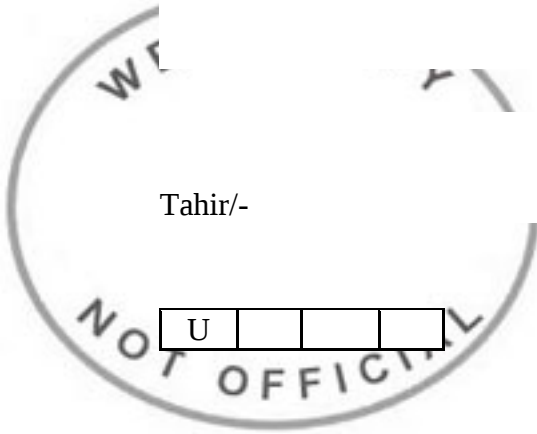
