Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner is apprehending arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 419, 420 and 120B of the Indian Penal Code.

The prosecution case is that subsequent to the recruitment of the petitioner as a constable it was gathered by the Superintendent of Police, Rohtas that on the date of written examination, the petitioner was found moving in the market area, hence, it was suspected that someone else appeared on behalf of the petitioner at the written examination, subsequently, notices were issued to the petitioner but the he failed to appear.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that only on suspicion, the accusation has been levelled. A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that the petitioner has no

criminal antecedent.

Considering the suspicious nature of accusation, let the above named petitioner be released on anticipatory bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned SDJM, Dehari-on-Sone, Rohtas in connection with Dehari (T) P.S. Case No. 530 of 2015, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
