learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises out of Danapur Police Station Case No. 387 of 2011, disclosing offences under Sections 147, 148, 341, 323, 384, 307 and 379 of the Indian Penal Code.

Considering the submission that the allegations against the petitioners are general and omnibus, this application is allowed.

Let the petitioners, namely, Vakil Rai, Subash Rai, Bahatter Rai @ Sri Niwash Rai and Dhaka Rai @ Om

Prakash @ Dakwan, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within four weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Danapur, in connection with Danapur Police Station Case No. 387 of 2011, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

This is subject to the condition that the petitioners shall present themselves before the police/Court, as the same may be, as and when required and in the event of failure on their part to appear before the Court on two consecutive occasions, their bail bonds shall be liable to be cancelled.
