The end result of the prayer which has been made in the writ application is inclusion of the petitioner in the Indian Administrative Service Cadre on the basis of Annexure-10.

Name of the petitioner figures at serial No.22 and he has been included in the select list provisionally.

Relief, therefore, which the petitioner is seeking through the present writ application, cannot be granted to him because this Court lacks jurisdiction by virtue of the provision of section 14 of the Central Administrative Tribunal Act 1986 and as amended from time to time. Obviously, the petitioner has approached a wrong forum. This Bench will not exercise any discretion or jurisdiction on such issue contrary to the statute. Petitioner is free to approach the

tribunal exercising power on such issue.

Writ application is dismissed. No opinion is expressed on the merit of the claim or assertion of the petitioner.
