counsel for the State.

The petitioners seek bail in connection with Deodha
P. S. Case No. 21 of 2015 registered under Section 302/34 of
the Indian Penal Code.

Regard being had to the allegation made in the FIR
that the petitioners along with two others killed the informant's
father with *dabiya* and *tengari* and in the post-mortem
examination, the doctor found four ante-mortem injuries on the
body of the deceased, I am not inclined to grant them bail.
Accordingly, the application for bail is rejected.
