3 09-02-2016 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

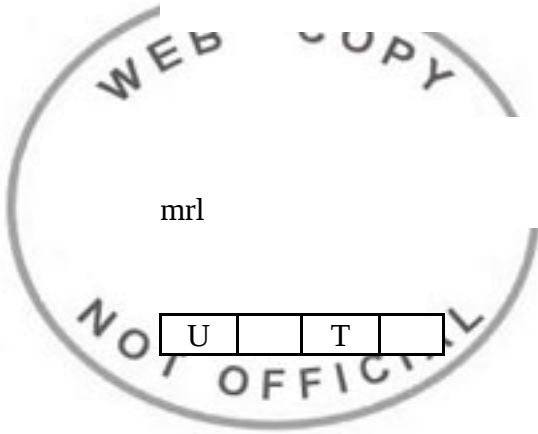
