2 16-03-2016 The petitioner has sought security to carry out his

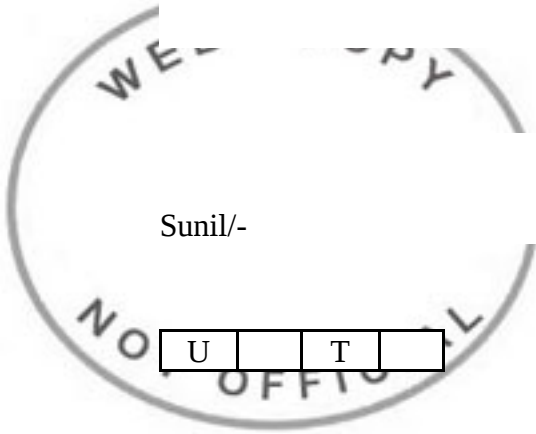
agricultural operation on his land measuring 6 *katha* and 12
