The prosecution case, as lodged by the informant, is that there was a fight between the petitioner side and the informant side in which both sides received injuries and the petitioner side also lodged First Information Report bearing Paharpur P.S. Case No. 155/15 for similar

offences.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that he is innocent having no criminal antecedent and one co-accused Binod Singh, who is alleged to have caused injury on one person of informant's side, who sustained injury and succumbed after 27 days and has been opined by the doctor to have died due to chronic illness, has since been granted the privilege of bail by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in Cr. Misc. No. 16481 of 2016 on 26.04.2016. He further submits that the injury alleged to have caused on the informant by the petitioner has been found to be simple in nature as per injury report.

However, learned APP for the informant as well as learned APP for the State submit that the petitioner is named in the First Information Report having caused injury on the informant, hence, oppose the prayer for bail.

Be that as it may, let petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of eight weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, East

Champan at Motihari, in connection with Paharpur P.S.
Case No. 154/15, subject to the conditions as laid down
under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
