2 08-01-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner no. 1 is father-in-law whereas petitioner no. 2 happens to be brother-in-law of the victim. The victim in her statement recorded under section 164 of the Cr.P.C stated that she was forcibly taken by the petitioner no. 2 but she did not make any complaint of ill-behaviour by the petitioner no. 2.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as well as submissions of the parties, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, Supaul in connection
