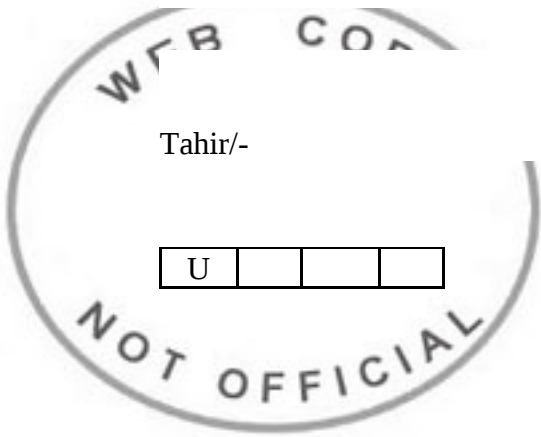
After some argument, the learned counsel appearing

with respect to lands claimed by him.
