Heard Mr. Pramod Mishra, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and Mr. Neeraj Kumar, the learned counsel appearing for the respondents.

The present application has been filed against the impugned order passed by the learned court below rejecting the prayer for review, as prayed, on behalf of the plaintiffs in Title Suit No. 113 of 1997.
