Heard learned counsel, M.K. Tiwary, appearing for the petitioner.

Perused the order dated 07.09.2015 passed by the Sub-Judge-8th, Saran at Chapra, whereby the court below has added the daughter-in-law as party-plaintiff in the final decree proceeding on the ground that the plaintiff- Rameshwar Prasad has made a *Will* with respect to his property in favour of daughter-in-law.

In view of the fact that the plaintiff, Rameshwar Prasad is not objecting to the addition of daughter-in-law in favour of whom a *Will* has been executed, the learned court below has rightly allowed the application. Therefore, I find no reason to interfere with the impugned order in exercise of supervisory jurisdiction. Thus, this writ application is dismissed.
