The writ application is dismissed on the sole ground that there is no legal infirmity emerging with regard to the enquiry report contained in Annexure-4, now as part of I.A. No.6462 of 2016, to be interfered with merely because the petitioner calls the said report to be collusive and a procured report. This is only an insinuation and not established by any facts or pleadings. That may not be good enough for this Court to interfere with the report on mere asking of the petitioner because the report is loaded against him.
