2 25-07-2016 Heard both sides.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in Pupari P.S. Case
No. 74/2013, registered for the offences punishable under Sections
304B, 201 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is submitted that petitioner is father-in-law of the
deceased, but his prayer for anticipatory bail petition was earlier
rejected vide order dated 27.03.2014 passed in Cr. Misc.
28095/2013. Some of the accused persons were arrested and the
police submitted charge-sheet. They were put on trial. During the
course of trial, five witnesses including the informant were
examined, but they did not support the prosecution case.

It appears that petitioner is father-in-law of the deceased,
the dead body of the deceased was hurriedly cremated and half

burnt dead body was recovered by the police on the information given by the informant and the present F.I.R. was lodged. The prayer for anticipatory bail petitioner was rejected vide order dated 27.03.2014 and for more than two years petitioner has been evading his arrest and did not surrender in the court below.

Considering the facts aforesaid, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner above-named on anticipatory bail. Accordingly, the same is rejected.

If the petitioner surrender in the court below within four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order and pray for regular bail learned court below shall consider his case on its own merit.
