The petitioners are permitted to agitate the issue before the Director, Primary Education, Government of Bihar with regard to the stand taken before this Court that they are governed by the second

Division Bench decision rendered in the case of Ramakant Yadav v. the State of Bihar & others, which was LPA No.1459 of 2013. The Court expresses no opinion on such a stand. The Court further makes it clear that no other aspect of such claim would be permitted to be raised by the petitioners except the fact that since they are appointees of the year 2000, they will be guided and covered by the second Division Bench decision in the case of Ramakant Yadav. Let an early decision be taken preferably within a period of three months.

Writ is disposed of with the above direction.
