Addl. Public Prosecutor.

The petitioner, who was mother-in-law of deceased,
has prayed for grant of anticipatory bail in Bochahan P.S. Case
No. 273 of 2014 registered for the offence under Sections
304(B)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and
considering the material on record, I do not find any ground to
extend the privilege of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.

It goes without saying that if the petitioner within a
period of six weeks from today surrenders before the court below
and makes a prayer for regular bail, the learned court below,
