The claim of the petitioners will be guided and decided in terms of the decision already rendered in the case of Sadanand Jha and Ors. V. the State of Bihar & Ors. passed in C.W.J.C. No. 9207 of

2012, copy of which is Annexure-2 to the writ application as well as the affirmance of the said order by the Division Bench in terms of Annexure-3.

The respondent-Administrator of Bihar State Road Transport Corporation has, therefore, a duty and obligation to make payment of statutory interest to the petitioners within a period of four months from the date of filing of an application with necessary details of the petitioners before the Administrator.

Writ is disposed of in terms of the above observation.
