Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises
out of Ahiyapur P.S. Case No. 131 of 2014, disclosing offences
under Sections-302/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

From the First Information Report, it is evident that
the petitioner has been named, merely, on the basis of suspicion.

From the case diary, learned Additional Public
Prosecutor appearing on behalf of the State has not been able to
point out any material collected, in course of investigation,
pointing petitioner's involvement in commission of the offence.

In the above, this application is allowed. Let the
petitioner, above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender

before the Court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Muzaffarpur in connection with Ahiyapur P.S. Case No. 131 of 2014, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
