ORAL ORDER

2 30-05-2016 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners being married sister and brother-in-law (Bahnoi) of the husband of the informant are apprehending arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 498A, 376/511 and 307 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

The basic accusation is of torture for non-fulfillment of the dowry demand. It is also alleged that the father of the husband of the informant attempted to ravish the informant.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the accusation against the petitioners is omnibus and general and

thrust of accusation is against the husband of the informant. The petitioners claim to be separate from the husband of the informant.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named petitioners be released on anticipatory bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Nawadah in connection with Nawadah Town P.S. Case No. 688 of 2015, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
