ORAL ORDER

7 29-06-2016 Sri Ashok Kumar Mishra , learned counsel for the petitioner, after some argument , in presence of learned AC to AAG - 10 as well as Sri Sharda Nand Mishra, learned counsel for the private respondent, makes a prayer for disposal of the present writ petition so that, petitioner may approach the Divisional Commissioner against the impugned order.

The writ petition stands disposed of with an indication that if any petition is filed by the petitioner before the Divisional Commissioner within a period of eight weeks from today, the

learned Divisional Commissioner may examine the same and pass appropriate order in accordance with law preferably within a period of three months after hearing all the concerned parties. Since private respondent has already appeared, the court expects that she may participate in the proceeding before the Divisional Commissioner.

The writ petition with above observation stands disposed of.
