from the vehicles on the direction of one Dr. S.N.A. Imam.

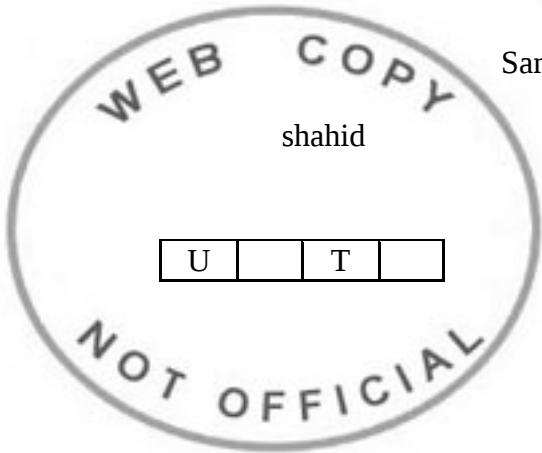
Petitioners are in jail custody since 30.5.2016 without
