22 bottles of Indian made foreign liquor are said to have been recovered from the house of the co-accused Lalo Chodhary. So far as petitioner is concerned, he happens to be son-in-law of the aforesaid co-accused Lalo Choudhary.

Submission on behalf of the petitioner is that petitioner being son-in-law of the aforesaid co-accused Lalo Choudhary had come to his house but, unfortunately, he was caught by the police when raid was conducted. Moreover, petitioner is in jail custody since 13.05.2016 and he does not have any criminal antecedent.

Accordingly, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two

sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional
Chief Judicial Magistrate-V, Begusarai in connection with
Sahebpur Kamal P.S.Case No. 72 of 2016.
