ORAL ORDER

2 13-07-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners are accused in connection with Thawe P.S. Case No. 52 of 2016 registered under Sections 272 and 273 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 47(A) of the Excise Act.

The accusation is of recovery of 12 bottles of foreign liquor, each contained in 750 ML, in the Bus of which the petitioner no. 1 and the petitioner no. 2 are conductor and Khalashi.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the alleged foreign liquor was not recovered from the possession of the petitioners. It is further submitted that petitioners are in

custody since 08.05.2016.

Having regard to the facts and the circumstances of the case, the petitioners above named, are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gopalganj, in connection with Thawe P.S. Case No. 52 of 2016. Out of two sureties, one surety must be the close relative of the petitioner.
