6 10-02-2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned
counsel appearing on behalf of O.P. No.2.

Both the couples are present as per the earlier direction.

However, there does not seem that any workable situation can appear out of the present scenario. Both the parties are adamant to press their own stand. However, since the petitioner is willing to keep his wife with all honour and dignity, but the sole condition of O.P. No.2 being that she will go with him only if he throws out his sister, who has been deserted by the brother of O.P. No.2, let the interim order regarding taking of no coercive steps merge into a final order, whereby

the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Bettiah, West Champaran, in connection with Complaint Case No.1554C of 2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
